The DRC will be responsible for (but not limited to):

- Match official development and education
- High Performance match assigning- including Ontario Cup, OSL Men and Woman, IModel competition, and events organized and ran by East Central Ontario Soccer Association
- Attend all Ontario Soccer Match Official Meetings as required
- Coordinate and host all district Match Official Fitness testing, including Regional and Provincial Upgrading education/fitness sessions

Our desired applicant will have ten or more years of referee experience as a match official in soccer.

-The desired applicant will ideally have experience in referee education.

-The desired applicant will ideally have experience in referee assignments.

-The desired applicant will ideally have experience in referee mentorship.

The successful applicant will be responsible for reporting directly to the ECOSA board of directors.

Compensation will be based on applicant experience of the above desired skills.

Position will be for a two-year term, with the potential of a 1 year extension before re-applying.
