



District Technical Coach (DTC)

As per our membership agreement discussed at our Annual Membership Meetings, ECOSA is committed to providing a transparent and equal opportunity for the position for all district positions.

The position of District Technical Coach (DTC) is a new position being introduced to ECOSA in 2026.

The position is a pilot position for two years with a potential one-year extension. The position will be responsible for developing its role, including but not limited to:

- Organizing Coaching Development courses including Learn to Train, Soccer for Life and Grassroots diploma
- Providing ongoing coaching support and development in the district for coaches and clubs from recreational and competitive.
- Build/design program for player and coach development
- Build/design program for indoor competitive play
- Provide support for our ECDSL events
- Other details or items that board of directors may add at discretion

The desired applicant will have ten or more years of coaching experience.

The desired applicant will hold a minimum of an Ontario Soccer C License Diploma, or the equivalent of Grass Roots Diploma. An Ontario Soccer B License/Can Soccer B Diploma is preferred. The desired application should be expected to show a clear plan of personal development to increase their Soccer Coaching Education knowledge.

The desired applicant may be required to put a development session plan together at the hiring panel's discretion, with the emphasis on training and developing coaches so they can develop players.

The position will be available for a 2 year term, with a one year potential renewal based on ECOSA board discretion. The position is based on an 12-month term (outside the summer season) for year one, to be developed for years 2 and 3. The expectation is the candidate will not hold a board position or staff position with any club of ECOSA to avoid bias perception,

Compensation is negotiable and based on experience, and plan projections over the term.
